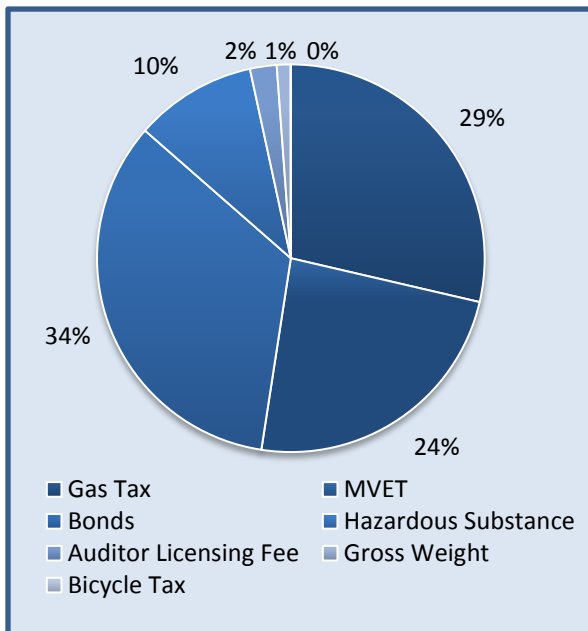

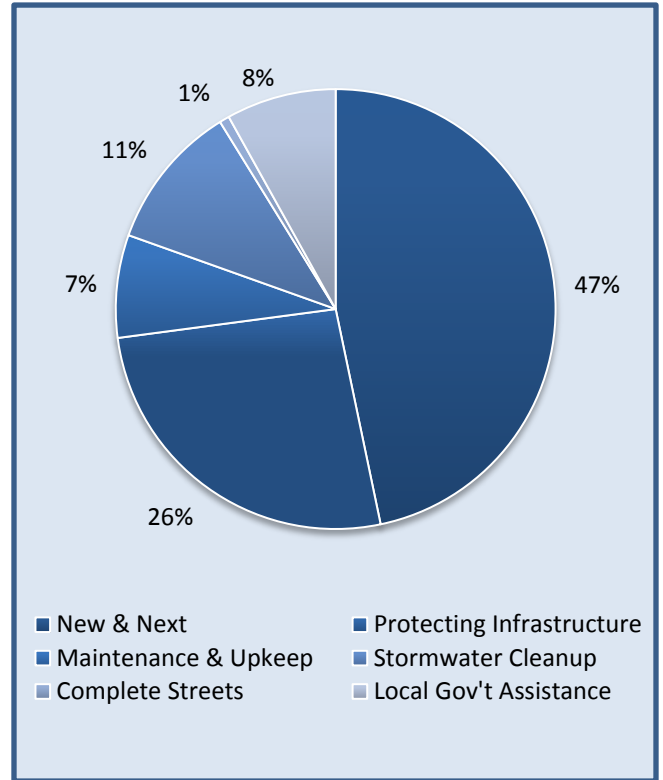

### Gasoline Tax (\$2,526m)

- 2 cent increase every year for five years

### Motor Vehicle Excise Tax (\$2,099m)

- 0.7 percent

### Bonds (\$3000m)

- \$1.5 billion each in years 5 and 7

### Hazardous Substance Tax (\$897m)

- 0.3 percent increase

### Auditor Licensing Fee (\$196m)

- \$5 registration, \$12 transfer at county auditor offices

### Commercial Gross Weight Fee (\$102m)

- 15 percent increase

### Bicycle Sales Fee (\$1m)

- \$25 fee on bicycles over \$500
